

KANDAHAR 2024

Alpine Ski World Cup February 2nd, 3rd and 4th, 2024

In the context of the organization of the Alpine Ski World Cup taking place in Les Houches from February 2nd to 4th, 2024, access to certain areas of the municipality will be restricted. Access will only be possible for residents, secondary residents, people working in the municipality unable to use public transportation, and vacationers staying in the municipality. The aim of this sectorization is to prevent the village from being clogged up by a massive influx of vehicles, which would entail risks for the safety of local residents (inability of emergency services to access the site) and for spectators attending the event.

To enable the mentioned people to access the controlled sectors of the municipality, a mandatory "pass" will have to be **sticked on the windshield** of the vehicle from February 2nd to 4th during filtering hours.

HOW TO OBTAIN YOUR CIRCULATION PASS?

- From January 8th to January 31st, 2024: Online application via a form available by clicking here or on the Les Houches town hall or tourist office website, by downloading the supporting documents specified below. (Please note: you must have a Google or Gmail account to access the form. If you don't have one, you can create one free of charge via this link: créer mon compte google)
- From January 22nd to February 1st: at the Les Houches tourist office, by bringing the supporting documents (every day from 9am to 12pm and from 2.30pm to 6.30pm).

Documents to be supplied:

- Residents, secondary residents: proof of residence + copy of the vehicle registration document (note: only one badge issued per vehicle).
- People working in the municipality unable to use public transportation: union card for ESF Les Houches instructors, employer's certificate for employees working in the municipality + copy of the vehicle registration document (note: only one badge issued per vehicle).
- Vacationers staying in the municipality: proof of accommodation reservation + copy of the vehicle registration document (note: only one badge issued per vehicle).




Passes do not grant access to parking lots.

To circulate, you must stick the pass corresponding to your place of residence or work on your windshield:

Badge B : City center (crossing the municipality from St Antoine to Bellevue) Badge C : City center (crossing the municipality from St Antoine to Bellevarde)

Badge M : Maisonneuve – Prarion – Chavants (complete crossing of the municipality to Maisonneuve)

Badge F : Flatière – Coupeau (crossing the municipality from St Antoine to Coupeau) Badge V* : Prarion – Chavants (complete crossing of the municipality to Belleface) Badge T** : Trabets (Crossing the municipality from St Antoine to Nant Jorland Road)



FILTERING HOURS

For sectors B, C, M and F:

- Friday, February 2nd and Saturday, February 3rd, 2024: 10 am. 3 pm.
- Sunday, February 4th, 2024: 7:30am 4pm.
- * Regarding the Prarion Chavants sector Badge V: Total closure of the Voza Pass road to all traffic, including residents, on Wednesday, January 31st, Thursday, February 1st, Friday, February 2nd, and Saturday, February 3rd, from 11:30 am to 2 pm, and Sunday, February 4th, from 9 am to 11 am and from 12 pm to 2 pm, except for emergency vehicles.
- ** Regarding the Trabets sector Badge T: On Friday, February 2nd, and Saturday, February 3rd, 2024, access is possible only for residents from 7 am to 10 am. Access will be completely closed to traffic, except for emergency vehicles, from 10 am to 3 pm. On Sunday, February 4th, from 7:30 am to 3 pm, total closure to all traffic (except for emergency vehicles), including residents.

HOW TO MOVE AROUND IN LES HOUCHES RESORT?

Warning! Offenders' vehicles will be systematically impounded and fined 35€

Access to the resort will be closed February 2nd and 3rd from 10am to 3pm and February 4th from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. to vehicles without a pass.

Access to Les Houches only via Saint Antoine and Georgeanne

Use public transportation!

Buses will be allowed through police checkpoints to take you to the lift departures and finish area. Parking will be strictly prohibited on **Friday, February 2nd, and Saturday, February 3rd, from 10am to 3pm and on Sunday, February 4th, from 7am to 3pm** on both sides of the road from Place de la Fruitière to the Maisonneuve chairlift, rue de l'Essert, Place de la Mairie, rue de l'Eglise and Avenue des Alpages.

SKI LIFTS AND SLOPES

Skiers will be able to reach the slopes via the Bellevue cable car and the Prarion gondola (access by public transport).

The entire ski area will be open to skiers, except for the "piste Verte Kandahar "reserved from Monday January 29th to Sunday February 4th, 2024 for preparation and competitions.
